Honey Classes

Class	Class Description
1	2 jars of light honey
2	2 jars of medium honey
3	2 jars of dark honey
4	2 jars of naturally granulated honey
5	2 jars of soft set honey
6	1 shallow frame of comb honey suitable for extraction (wired or unwired)
7	1 container of cut comb Gross weight 200-255g (7-9oz)
8	1 section of comb honey (shape unrestricted)
9	1 jar of honey to be judged on taste only

Beeswax and Candles Classes

Class	Class Description
10	3 x 28g (1oz) moulded matching blocks of beeswax
11	1 piece of beeswax 200-255g not patterned & not less than 18mm thick
12	3 moulded matching candles to be displayed erect (one will be lit by judge)
13	3 matching candles produced by a method other than by moulding to be displayed erect (one will be lit by judge)

Mead Classes

Class	Class Description
14	1 bottle of dry mead
15	1 bottle of sweet mead
16	1 bottle of melomel or metheglin

Marmalade and Preserves

Class	Class Description
17	1 jar of marmalade, any citrus fruit, containing honey
18	1 home-produced product in a clear glass container selected from conserves, preserves, chutneys, mustards, pickles and honey vinegars to contain honey as the main sweetener.

Photographic

Class	Class Description
19	1 Black and white or colour print of any subject relating to bees or beekeeping.

Decorative or Artistic

Class	Class Description
20	Any decorative or artistic exhibit relating to bees or beekeeping
21	Any Artistic, Decorative, Interesting or Instructive Exhibit, relating to Bees or Bee- keeping (Open to individuals only who are under 18 years of age on the first day of the show). A written explanation of the exhibit is permitted.
22	A Honey Label. A standard label of your own design.
23	Skep – To be made by the exhibitor.

24	1 Devonshire honey cake – Specified recipe must be used
25	1 fruit honey cake – Specified recipe must be used
26	Decorated honey sponge.
27	6 honey biscuits
28	Honey Fudge – Specified recipe must be used
