Nectar and Pollen plants for honeybees

Remember that bumble bees have long tongues whilst honeybees' tongues are shorter.

This means that plants may not be suitable for both species.

Choose single-flowered plants as much as possible because complex snowdrops, dahlias etc, may not provide forage that is accessible to bees.

The following list mentions some trees and plants that produce nectar, pollen or both. It is by no means comprehensive, and does not allow for the changing weather patterns of the last quarter century. The list was abridged and taken from *Beekeeping Study Notes*, (Second Edition) by JD and BD Yates.
